
Dear Members

Congress Guidelines

As agreed in Suwon, Korea, the Congress Hosting Guidelines and associated documents required some revision based on the changing global climate.

Congress 2024

The bids received for Congress 2024 were reviewed and the Board is now in consultation with the preferred provider, The Singapore Association for Medical Laboratory Sciences (SAMLS), with a view to reaching an agreement. We expect this to happen before April and that we will be in a position to present the location for the 2024 GAD for your approval shortly thereafter.

Alternate GAD 2023

As agreed the location for the Alternate GAD in 2023 is Dublin, Ireland. The proposed date is the 6th to 8th October.

Further details will follow.

Management Committee Meeting

The Management Committee will meet in Dublin at the end of February. This will be the 1st 'in person' meeting of the committee since the start of Covid.

This meeting will consider the Alternate GADs in 2023 and plan for 2025 along with Congresses in 2024, 2026 and beyond.

We expect to issue calls for applications to host the 2025 and 2026 meetings in the 2nd Quarter of this year.
